Meet Director at Warrior Square Station, St. Leonards. Proceed to 8, Grand Parade (few minutes' walk), where light refreshments will be provided by Mrs. Lewis Abbott. Numerous objects of interest will be on view, illustrating things to be seen later in the field.

Drive to Fairlight Church along part of the Fairlight-Brightling anticline, offering magnificent views of South Wealden denudation. Visit quarry in Milk White Sandstone near base of Ashdown Sands. Walk through wild and beautiful scenery, past several Neolithic and Hastings Kitchen Midden Men Settlements, to
